Metaldyne Exercises Option to Acquire Twinsburg, Ohio Plant

Plymouth Mich. – November 16, 2009 – Metaldyne, LLC today announced it has exercised its option to include the aluminum die casting plant in Twinsburg, Ohio as part of Metaldyne Powertrain Components, Inc. (a subsidiary of Metaldyne, LLC). The Twinsburg plant has 125 employees.

“We are pleased to have successfully completed negotiations with the many stakeholders of Twinsburg and added this operation to our global business,” said Thomas Amato, president & chief executive officer of Metaldyne, LLC. “This is a very dynamic time for Metaldyne as we enhance the focus of our technologies on new engine, transmission, and driveline applications.”

The Twinsburg plant will be part of Metaldyne’s Driveline & Balance Shaft Module business. Twinsburg casts aluminum transmission valve bodies, end covers, housings and various other die cast products.

Metaldyne, LLC is a new company formed on October 16, 2009. The company acquired a majority of the assets of the former Metaldyne Corporation (now known as Oldco M Corporation). Metaldyne, LLC’s parent company is MD Investors Corporation, which is primarily controlled by the Carlyle Group, one of the largest private equity funds in the world.
